



Spring 2019 Word of Life Music School

- Class times vary but are generally available afternoons and evenings Monday – Thursday.
- Classes are open to kids ages 6 and up and adults of all skill levels.

Tuition Options

Tuition for all classes: \$300 per class per semester if paid in full the first day of class. We offer a monthly payment option of \$65. Paid in advance at the first lesson of each month. There is a \$35 per student enrollment fee. Please add this to your first payment due at the first lesson. Students enrolled for the Fall semester will not be subject to the enrollment fee for the Spring semester if all payments are current.

A special discount is available for those that currently serve on a Word of Life Center Music Team. The rate of \$250 per class, per semester is available when paid in full in advance or \$55 a month paid in advance the 1st lesson of each month. *Discount only applies to the individual serving on a music team. Does not apply to family members.

Registration Information

1.) You may phone the instructor of the class or classes you are interested in to set a day and time for your lesson. (See Phone numbers below)

2.) Fill out and bring the completed Enrollment Agreement Form, payment, and the \$35 enrollment fee to your first lesson. All payments will be made to your instructor. Those with multiple classes and instructors will pay your total enrollment to your first instructor of the school week. *Returning Fall 2018 students in good standing will not pay the \$35 Registration Fee.

- Classes begin January 7th but registration will remain open through March 2019.

Music School Policies

Class Cancellation

- Music School classes are only cancelled if Caddo Schools classes or after school activities are cancelled due to weather. (Not holidays, only weather)
- We may also, at our discretion, cancel classes if it becomes or may become hazardous for students or faculty to travel. If in doubt, please call: 318-688-4411 ext. 123 or your instructor.
- Classes cancelled due to weather or power outage are not made up.

Missed Classes

- If you need to miss a class, we ask that you contact your teacher if you know you will be missing a class.
- There are no make-up class offered if you miss a class.
- Please let your teacher know if you will be more than 5 minutes late, if no students have arrived 10 minutes after a scheduled start time, the teacher may choose to cancel that class.
- If a teacher must miss a class for any reason, a substitute teacher will lead the class, or a make-up lesson will be offered.
- Every effort will be made to schedule the make-up class at a convenient time for the student. If you miss your make-up lesson it will not be rescheduled.

Payments

- Semester payments are due the 1st lesson of the semester. The semester discount is only available the first month of the semester.
- Monthly payments are due the 1st lesson of each month. Months will not be prorated.
- If a payment is more than 2 weeks late or if a student does not attend a class for more than 2 consecutive weeks without calling, they may lose their time-slot and may incur enrollment fees to resume classes.

No student or person waiting for a student may become disruptive to classes or those working at Word of Life Center at any time. Repeated warnings may lead to expulsion without refund.

At no time will a parent allow their children, whether student or sibling, to be unattended. Please do not drop students off early or be late to pick them up without adult supervision.

If it ever becomes necessary to drop a class please e-mail or call the Music School Administrator and your instructor. This will allow us to offer your time slot to another student and you will remain in good standing with the school and may re-enroll in the future.

The Word Of Life Music School is a smoke free environment; please do not smoke in or near our buildings.
